### Readiness and coaching

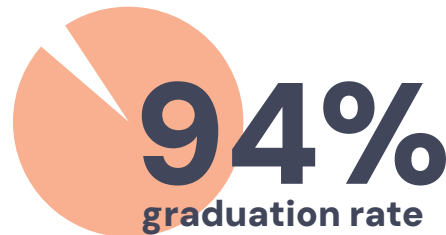
**45 women**

who entered employment training programs previously participated in coaching and readiness services



### Training programs

**16 employment training programs**



### Financial supports

**59% of grads**

required additional financial support to complete WBF programs



## Safe and affordable housing

**73 women and children**

lived in WBF safe and affordable housing in Edmonton

**41%** were Indigenous

**45%** were unemployed



## A brighter future for our graduates and their families

**169 women**

graduated from employment training programs

**38%**

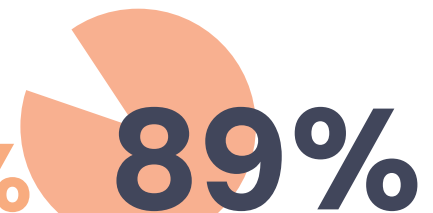
were previously unemployed (the rest were largely underemployed)

**33%**

had dependents or children - 1/5 were single parents

**20%**

were Indigenous



**of graduates were hired** in fields related to their training within six months of graduation

**19 alumni**

who graduated in previous years connected with WBF and found new employment
